

1. Your song must be a rock song. 103GBF is a rock station. That means it must be somewhat compatible with our format. It can be mainstream rock, alternative rock, punk rock, rap rock, aggro, emo... whatever, but it has to be rock of some kind. Also, your song must be original. Any band can do covers... it's takes genuine talent to create your own music.
2. The song must be of studio quality. Professional studio or basement studio... doesn't matter as long as it's mastered. It has to sound good... no hissy, noisy or hand held mic recordings. If your song is poorly recorded it has no chance of being played on LOCAL 103.
3. Content and language DO matter! 103GBF is a commercial radio station. We have to abide by the FCC rules and regulations. We won't play anything that will get us fined. Everyone knows the words you can't say on radio... We won't edit your songs for you; we just won't play them if they violate government guidelines. Also, if you want to worship Satan or kill your relatives... do it on your own time. We won't play that stuff either. Since we will not edit your song for you, we solve the problem by just not playing the song.
4. The length of your song is a factor. The average rock track is between 3 to 5 minutes in length. Please do not exceed these averages by too much.
5. Your song must be submitted on CD. That's the format. No tape, MP3, etc.
6. We will not be responsible for returning your CD's. Once you submit your music your CD will not be returned unless arrangements have already been made.
7. We will not be held responsible for any copyright laws that you may violate. If you plagiarize, or submit something that was written by someone without their approval, you are responsible. We won't be sued over any of that stuff.
8. This is not a contest. Just an attempt to give exposure to local bands. Your band must be based within the 103GBF listening area. We don't want bands from Louisville, Indy, or wherever taking up your space. Also, we don't care if you gig or not. If your song meets the guidelines mentioned here, that's enough.
9. We make no guarantees your song will air.
10. Please include a brief band bio with your submission... who you are, where you're from, a short band history, gigs, etc. Also you must print the required information into the blanks below, sign this criteria form, and include this form when you submit your music. Submissions not accompanied by a signed copy of this disclaimer will not be considered for airplay during LOCAL 103.
11. There are two ways to submit your music. You can drop off your package at our offices at 117 SE 5th Street (downtown at the corner of 5th and Walnut) in Evansville during regular business hours Monday-Friday 8am through 5pm. If this is not an option, you can mail your package to:
